Thanks to the members of the HOF who have come forward to help the League adjust to these needs. Bill Svetz, HOF'05 aided in obtaining additional field permits at Clemente. He and Frank Ribaudo, HOF'05 also have come forward to sponsor the two newest teams that were created from "Clinic Day" in 2007 and 2008 (Fritz Bubbles & Club Café Bandits). Seth Hyde, HOF'06 also stepped up to assist in coaching the "Club Café Bandits" along with Frank for their manager (Club Café Angels player Todd Askew.) 5 Star Travel: Sponsoring & Serving the BSL for 14 years now!

5 Star Travel was founded in '82 by Anne Romano, mother of the former "Ramrod" manager, Jeff. In '91 Paul Moreno, HOF'05 & Stephen Barlow, HOF'05, bought the agency and focused primarily on serving the gay travel community. They even almost changed its name to "Girls on Vacation" or "Pink Travel"! It has since: grown from a 600K per year business to \$3 Million in annual sales with 6 agents, won numerous awards, and is respected across the USA.

In '95 Paul & Stephen began "Community Share" where 5 Star donates a portion of its sales to non-profits (including the BSL). '95 was also the 1st year they sponsored a BSL team, the former GBBC 'Boston Bucks' which became the "5 Star Generals". After many of the 'General' originals retired or went their separate ways, 5 Star created a new team of predominantly Latino players called the "Diablos" organized by Jack Campbell, *HOF'07*, managed by Ed Rivera, *HOF'07*, and coached by Gary Brenner, *HOF'05*. Henry Weinberger, *HOF'05* will manage the very energetic & exciting team this season.
