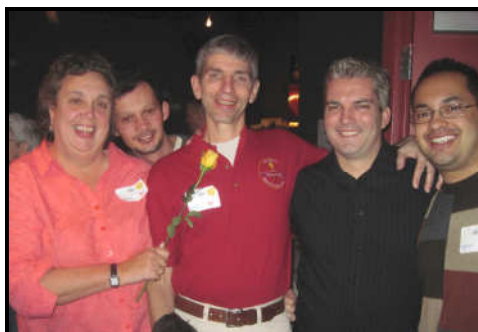
Winter Social Draws Full House!

League News – 2010 Season :

Gay softball in Boston begins its 33rd season on May 1! A record 26 teams in 4 Divisions with nearly 500 members begin 2010 at opening ceremonies on Smith Field. Then, on July 3-4, the BSL hosts the 13th Minuteman Tournament!

The 2010 'Clinic Day' attracted over 50 new players to the BSL. It also created 2 new "Clinic Day" teams which will be coached by Bill Hull, HOF'05, & Mike Salvi.
